Dear Parents/Carers,

Well, we have a week and a half to go until our Goblin Race Day on Wednesday 20th June at Newquay Airport. So here are the final arrangements for the day.

As car scrutineering (safety check) starts at 8:30am; we have booked a coach to pick the children up from school at the unearthly hour of 7:15 am but children will need to be at school (using the art room door) by 7:05am. Sorry! Please note, we will leave at 7:15am on the dot, so late-comers will miss out!

Children should wear School PE Kit, making sure they have **long sleeves** and tracksuit bottoms/leggings on. Long hair must be tied back (or the ability to do so). There will be refreshments available on site - but please pack your child with enough food and drink to last them on what is certainly going to be a very long day. Those children entitled to a free school meal will be provided with one (form attached) . There is also an opportunity to order a pre-paid packed lunch, please complete and return packed lunch forms by **Wednesday 13th June**. Also make sure you pack sun cream, a hat or cap and enough clothes to keep them warm or dry if the weather is inclement. Please note, even if the forecast is for sunny weather, it can be very cold and windy on the airfield, so ensure that they have their school jumper. We aim to leave Newquay at around 3:45pm and should return to school by approximately 5:15pm.

We have booked a 48 seater coach, so there are roughly 15 spaces for parents, grandparents, other family members and supporters if you would like to come along and support the team. The school is subsidising this event, so we will only be asking for £5.00 towards transport for each child, however we would ask that any supporters pay £6.00 per seat on the coach - much cheaper than a tank of petrol. Please note, the full cost per child is actually £12.40, so if you are able to pay more than the £5.00, we would really appreciate it. If you would like to come along and spend the day with us, then please fill in the tear off slip below - the extra seats will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Anyone wishing to make their own way down to Newquay, **MUST** inform me in advance, as I sometimes have to inform RAF St Mawgan of the number plates of any vehicles entering the airport site.

We have an action-packed day ahead of us, involving lots of different sorts of races, cheer-leading and the opportunity to get involved with hands-on science and technology exhibitions. Sometimes the fire and police service bring vehicles for the children to explore and in the past we have had demonstrations of Tesla electric cars racing each other down the runway! All in all, it is a brilliant day out.
