Pick one of the following activities every week. It is your choice which order you do them in.

<p>Numbers, Shape, space and measures</p> <p>Practise finding 1 more and 1 less to numbers up to 20.</p> <p>You can show this by drawing objects and adding 1 more or crossing 1 out to show less. You could write number sentences such as $5 + 1 = 6$ or $6 - 1 = 5$.</p>	<p>Expressive arts and design</p> <p>Can you think of or learn a song that has actions? Can you teach it to the rest of the class?</p>	<p>Communication and Language</p> <p>Can you tell us about something that interests you? Do you have a favourite book, game or television show that you could talk about? You could take a photo, draw a picture or bring it in.</p>	<p>Knowledge and understanding of the world</p> <p>This term's topic is all about celebrations. Pick a celebration from your culture and tell us about it. How do you celebrate it with your family? What food do you eat? Do you sing any songs or give gifts? For example, how do you celebrate Bonfire night, Christmas or Ramadan?</p>
<p>Personal, Social and Emotional Understanding</p> <p>It is very important that we know how to stay safe. Can you make a poster explaining how and why we can stay safe? For example, 'Be Safe, Be seen', how to hold scissors when walking, stranger danger or staying safe online.</p>	<p>Writing</p> <p>Begin to use real letters to write CVC words. Find an activity sheet in the homework tray. Alternatively draw and label your own pictures.</p>	<p>Reading</p> <p>Finding words that rhyme. Can you spot the sounds that make words rhyme and create a rhyming list? For example, Pot, lot, dot, got, hot,</p>	<p>Physical development</p> <p>Practise your cutting skills. Can you make something that requires you to cut and join pieces together?</p>
