Homework Policy

The activities described will be set on a weekly basis. The children will be given a minimum of 2 days to complete the work.

FOUNDATION STAGE

Reception

- Reading at home as often as possible
- Activities to develop numeracy and literacy skills

KEY STAGE 1

Year 1 / Year 2

- Reading to include school scheme books, library books and children's chosen texts, as often as possible
- Spelling / phonics
- Mathematical activity

KEY STAGE 2

Year 3 / Year 4 - tasks will be set each week as follows:-

- Reading - the nature of which depends on the level of the child's ability
- Spelling
- Maths
- Extension activity (when appropriate)

Year 5 / Year 6 - tasks will be set each week as follows:-

- Maths
- Reading - the nature of which depends on the level of the child's ability
- Spelling
- Extension activity (when appropriate)

No child is expected to spend more than 30 minutes per night completing homework. If your child is not managing to complete this homework within 1/2 hour per night please inform his / her teacher.

Our intention is not to reduce children's out of school activities nor to spoil family life!
