Dear Parents/Carers,

I am delighted to be writing to inform you that we have booked an exciting trip to Morwellham Quay on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> November. While we are there, we will be taking a trip on the mine train, experiencing life in a Victorian school room, learning about child labour in Victorian time by breaking rocks in search of copper ore, and learning how to make rope the traditional way! It should be a fantastic educational and fun-filled experience that will really benefit the children's learning linked with our term's topic.

We will be travelling by coach, leaving school at approximately 9:00am and returning just before the end of the school day. The children will need to bring a packed lunch. If your child is entitled to a free school meal or would like to order a school packed lunch, please complete the attached form and return it to school by Monday 20<sup>th</sup> November. Due to the fact that the trip will go ahead whatever the weather, your child will need to wear a waterproof coat and sensible shoes.

Thanks to the school and the PTA heavily subsidising the trip, we will only be asking for a voluntary contribution of £8 towards the cost of the coach and entry to Morwellham, which can be paid via [www.schoolmoney.co.uk](http://www.schoolmoney.co.uk). However, if we do not receive enough money, we will be forced to cancel the trip, which would be a massive disappointment for the children. If you are able to pay the full cost of the trip, which is £14.30, we would be very grateful; this option will be a top-up in the school money shop.
