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| <p>Reading Inference</p> | <p>To participate in discussions about stories and make inferences on the basis of what is being said or done.</p> <p><i>Gingerbreads</i> - I can say what a character might be feeling in a story, and listen to other children's ideas too.</p> <p><i>Dragons , Gruffalos and Bears</i> - I can say pick up clues in a story on the basis of what is being said or done, and take part in a discussion about them.</p> <p><i>Giants and Wild Things</i> - I can pick up clues in a story on the basis of what is being said or done, and find exact words and phrases in the text to help explain my ideas.</p> |
| <p>Writing Grammar</p> | <p>1st - I can combine words orally to make a sentence and then write all the words.</p> <p>2nd - I can use suffixes on verbs (when no change is needed to the root word) eg, <i>-ed -ing - er -est</i></p> <p>3rd - I understand the words <i>letter, capital letter, word, singular, plural, sentence, punctuation, full stop, question mark, exclamation mark</i> and can use them when discussing my writing.</p> |
| <p>Maths Measures</p> | <p><i>1st</i> - I can begin to compare the weight of objects, using lighter than/heavier than and begin to record this. I can begin to compare objects for length and say which is longer than, which is shorter than other objects. I can begin to compare objects for volume and say which is full/ empty, more than and less than.</p> <p><i>2nd</i> - I can compare and order the weight of objects, using lighter than/heavier than and record this. I can compare and order objects for length, using the language longer than, shorter than (other objects) and record this. I can compare and order objects for volume full/empty, more than, less than, half full, quarter.</p> <p><i>3rd</i> - I can solve problems involving measure in mass (heavier than, lighter than, same as), volume (full/empty, more than, less than, half full, quarter full) and length (longer than, shorter than) knowing that when comparing length each item must start at the same point and irregular items (such as wiggly string) needs to be laid straight.</p> |
