<u>Reading</u> <u>How a text works (Non -Fiction)</u>	Red and Blue	I can use a contents list and index and talk about what a book may be about by looking at the cover, title, and illustrations
	Green and Yellow	I can understand how to use a contents list and index and talk about what a text is about by skim-reading a double page spread.
	Purple	I can understand how to use a contents list and index and talk about what a text is about by skim-reading a double page spread. I can use non-fiction features - contents list, index, glossary - to scan a text and decide if it would be a useful book for a particular reader.
<u>Writing</u> <u>Handwriting.</u>	Red	Form lower-case letters of the correct size relative to on another. Start using some of the diagonal and horizontal strokes needed to join letters and understand which letters, when adjacent to one another, are best left un-joined.
	Blue and Green	Use the diagonal and horizontal strokes that are needed to join letters and understand which letter, when adjacent to one another, are best left un-joined.
	Yellow and Purple	Increase the legibility, consistency and quality of their handwriting (e.g. down-strokes parallel and equidistant)
<u>Maths</u> <u>Multiplications</u>	Red	Consolidate multiplication and division facts for 10, 2 and 5. Begin to recall and use multiplication facts for the 3 times tables.
	Blue and Green	Consolidate multiplication and division facts for 10, 2 and 5. Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3 and 4 multiplication tables.
	Yellow and Purple	Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 10, 2, 5, 3 and 4 multiplication tables. I can solve problems that involve using the 3,4 and 8 times tables.
