<u>Subject</u>	<u>Group</u>	<u>Target</u>
<u>Reading</u> Inference and deduction	Red	I can sometimes find words and phrases in a story to explain what I think it is about.
	Blue and Green	I can find words and phrases in a story to explain what I think it is happening.
	Yellow and Purple	I can think of other words and phrases that the author could have used and say why
<u>Writing</u> Punctuation	Red and Blue	When reading, take account of punctuation, including inverted commas, and sometimes vary their intonation/expression appropriately. When writing, begin to use inverted commas when a character speaks with support.
	Green and Yellow	When reading, take account of punctuation, including inverted commas, and vary their intonation/expression appropriately. When writing, begin to use inverted commas when a character speaks.
	Purple	When reading, take account of punctuation, including inverted commas, and vary their intonation/expression appropriately, making their voice interesting for their audience. When writing, use inverted commas when a character speaks and begin to use other punctuation within speech.
<u>Maths</u> Time	Red and Blue	Use vocabulary such as o'clock, a.m./p.m., morning, afternoon, noon and midnight.
	Green	Tell and write the time using analogue clocks, on the nearest minute, on a 12 hour clock.
	Yellow and Purple	Tell and write the time from an analogue clock, including using Roman numerals from I to XII, and 12-hour and 24-hour clocks.
