<p>Reading (interpretation and response)</p>	<p><u>Magicians</u> - I can talk about why I think writers have chosen specific words or phrases. <u>Magicians 2</u> - I can talk about the theme of a story and about why things happen. <u>Fire-breathers/Clowns</u> – I can talk about how a writer has developed a character through action, description and dialogue. <u>Jugglers/Ringmasters</u> - I can say whether a writer has been successful in their purpose e.g. to make me laugh, cry, think etc.</p>
<p>Writing (Punctuation)</p>	<p><u>Aliens</u> - When reading, with support, identify brackets, dashes or commas that indicate parenthesis. When writing, begin to use brackets to include additional information. <u>Aliens 2</u> - When reading, begin to draw inference about a character’s feelings based on what they say while also identifying the punctuation within inverted commas. When writing, begin to correctly punctuate direct speech. <u>Rockets/Astronauts</u> - When reading, identify and discuss the use of brackets, dashes and commas that indicate parenthesis and the effect their use may create (e.g. humour, intrigue etc). When writing, use brackets, dashes and commas for parenthesis correctly. <u>Comets/Stars</u> - When reading, identify and discuss the use of brackets, dashes and commas that indicate parenthesis and the effect their use may create (e.g. humour, intrigue etc). When writing, use brackets, dashes and commas for parenthesis correctly across a range of contexts taking into consideration the effect they can create.</p>
<p>Maths (Time)</p>	<p><u>Bright sparks</u> - Begin to solve problems involving converting between units of time <u>Whizz Kids/Superstars</u> - Solve problems involving converting between units of time i.e 1 hour and 30 minutes = 90 minutes. 1 minute 30 seconds = 90 seconds. Solve problems converting time between days and months and years. <u>Clever clogs/Smarty pants</u> - Use and apply their knowledge of converting between units of time (hours, minutes, days, months and weeks) in a range of situations.</p>
