Reading Know How Texts work Fiction	Roald Dahls	I can identify the structures and features of different fiction text-types, e.g. science fiction, adventure, myths, legends.
	David Walliams Michael Morpurgo Cressida Cowell	I can describe the text structures and language features of some different writers and poets.
	Anthony Horowitz	I can say whether a fiction text or poem has been successful, commenting on purpose, audience, structure and use of language.
Writing Punctuation	Simile	When reading, begin to identify hyphens in texts and with support, discuss why it is being used. When writing, use a hyphen correctly (with support).
	Alliteration Personification Onomatopoeia	In reading, identify the use of a hyphen to avoid ambiguity. When writing, begin to use a hyphen correctly.
	Metaphor	In reading, identify the use of a hyphen to avoid ambiguity and suggest alternatives for how it could have caused confusion if used differently. When writing, use a hyphen correctly in a range of contexts.
Maths Division	Archimedes	Begin to divide numbers up to 4 digits by a two digit number. Starting informally and working up to formal written methods of long division. Begin to understand remainders as whole numbers or fractions.
	Pythagoras Fibonacci	Divide numbers up to 4 digits by a two-digit whole number using the formal written method of long division, and interpret remainders as whole number remainders, fractions, or by rounding, as appropriate for the context.
	Einstein	Use and apply their knowledge of dividing numbers, up to 4 digits by a two-digit whole number using the formal written method of long division, to solve real life problems.
