

School Improvement Plan: summary

Our School Improvement Plan has been written primarily to cater for the needs of the future development of the children of College Road Primary School in the light of our statement of philosophy, which reads as follows:-

Hand in hand for the next step.

We are here to embrace each child's individuality and to provide exciting opportunities which enable all members of our school community to reach their full potential.

The main School Improvement priorities for College Road Primary School for 2018/ 2019 can be briefly summarised as follows:-

- 1 – To continue to raise standards in all curriculum subjects for all children, focussing again this year on improving attainment in writing, via the use of punctuation, handwriting and spelling.**
- 2 – Achieve the 'Values based Education' kitemark, thus ensuring that an ethical, values-based approach positively affects the school's children and families.**
- 3 – Work and collaborate with an increasing range of partners from the education sector through to private concerns, so widening our own expertise and opportunities for the children of the school.**

All the school's stakeholders have been consulted, and had direct input to the main areas for our improvement.
